The second cluster of the Summer Placement process for the PGP class of 2026 was held today at the Indian Institute of Management Ahmedabad. The firms that participated in Cluster 2 comprised of seven cohorts – "Conglomerates", "Retail B2B & Retail E-commerce", "Consumer Goods", "Consumer Durables", "Pharmaceuticals & Health Care".

We saw a large pool of recruiters recruiting for **53 roles of various kinds**. Overall Mahindra from the "Conglomerates" cohort and Amazon from "Retail B2B & Retail E-commerce" were the largest recruiters with 8 offers each. They were followed by Hindustan Unilever Limited (HUL) from the "Consumer Goods" cohort with 7 offers. Sun Pharmaceuticals, Lodha Ventures and Aditya Birla Group were next with 6 offers each.

The Conglomerate cohort saw the participation of regular recruiters like Aditya Birla Group, CK Birla Group, JSW Group and Tata Administrative Services. Bharti Enterprises was a new recruiter in this cohort recruiting for its Group Treasury, M&A and Corporate Finance Teams. Airtel was the largest recruiter in the "Consumer Services" cohort making 3 offers.

The Consumer Goods included regular recruiters like AB InBev, Loreal, Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverages, Asian Paints, Coca-Cola, United Breweries (Heineken), Dabur, HUL, ITC, Nestle, Diageo, Wipro Consumer Care. The Pharma & Health Care cohort showed great confidence in the talent pool with active participation from Sun Pharma, Dr. Reddy's Laboratories, Emcure Pharmaceuticals, Glenmark Pharmaceuticals and Bharat Serum Vaccines.

We witnessed rise in the participation of firms visiting for the first time in summers such as GMR Group, Bharti Enterprises, Emcure Pharmaceuticals, Bharat Serum Vaccine, Michelin India, Sony, Welspun Living, United Breweries (Heineken), Zydus Wellness. New-age startup Trampoline Store also visited for the first time making 2 offers for its Founder's Office role.
