**C6. Percentage of marks in the bachelor's examination  $\geq$  Minimum cut-off percentage**, to be set at the 80<sup>th</sup> percentile of the percentage of marks of the respective AC group of the applicants' pool.

CS (Composite Score) = 0.35 (Normalized AR score) + 0.65 (Normalized overall score in CAT-2025)

CS = (AR\*0.35/38) + (Overall CAT score\*0.65/204)
